The six **IAAF Indoor Permit** meetings and various national indoor championships over the past month have provided just a taste of what to expect at the **IAAF World Indoor Championships**. And if the performances so far this year are anything to go by, there will be much to look forward to when the world's best track and field athletes descend upon the Polish city of Sopot on 7-9 March.

There will barely be enough time to pause for breath after the World Indoors as just three weeks later the focus turns to the roads when the Danish capital of Copenhagen hosts the **IAAF World Half Marathon Championships** on 29 March. The 19th edition of the global event will also provide the opportunity to the masses of running alongside the world's best athletes in a **'Run with the champions'** mass-participation race held alongside the elite events.
